

Central Library Accessibility

How to get there:

By bus:

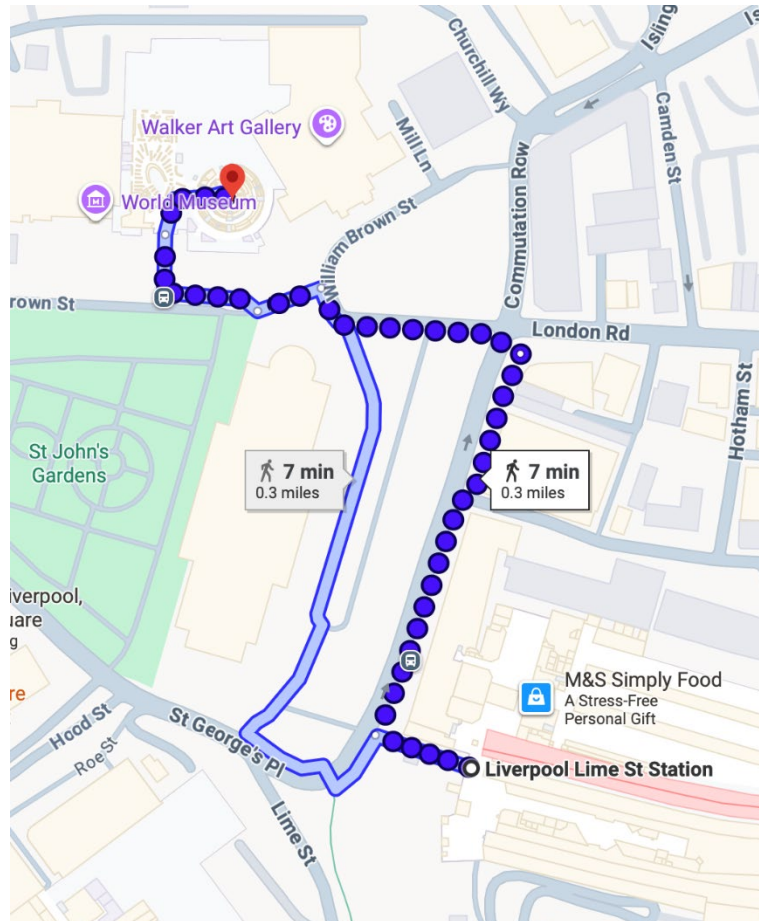
These bus lines stop near Liverpool Central Library: 14B, 19, 20, 407, 437, 54A, 79C, 82.

The nearest bus station is Queen Square Bus Station; it is approximately a 5-minute walk to Liverpool Central Library from here. From the Bus station you can walk through St John's Gardens to easily reach the library. Alternatively, you can walk around St George's Hall.



By train:

The nearest train station to Liverpool Central Library is Lime Street Station. From here, it is a 7-minute walk along Lime St and across William Brown St to the Library.



Parking options:

- Q-Park Queen Square (L1 1RH): 24-hour secure parking, very close to the library.
- St John's Shopping Centre (L1 1NQ): Convenient for short stays, located opposite.
- Dale Street Car Park (L2 2AH): Council-run surface car park, open 7.30am–7.30pm.
- Mount Pleasant Car Park (L3 5TF): Larger 24/7 multi-storey option.
- On-Street Parking: Limited pay-and-display bays on surrounding streets (e.g., William Brown Street, Cuerden Street, Hunter Street).
- Blue Badge Holders: Holders can park for free in designated bays and on-street pay-and display bays. There are a limited number of blue badge parking spaces on William brown Street, outside the museum. The road surface is cobbled.

• **Facilities/accessibility available:**

- Free WIFI available
- Automatic entrance doors
- Accessible lift
- Accessible toilets
- Changing Places toilet available

The Picton Reading Room on the 1st floor is a quiet reading space which might provide a break from the noise and excitement should you need it.



Alternatively, St John's Gardens is just across from Central Library and might also provide a quiet break away if needed.



Places to eat lunch:

There are lots of lunch spots within a few minutes' walk from Liverpool Central Library. If you choose to bring your own lunch, there will be places available within the library where you will be able to eat your lunch, please just ask a member of The Brain Charity team if you are unsure.

The 'Relish' Café in Liverpool Central Library is inside the library and is good for quick sandwiches, drinks and snacks.



The World Museum next door to the library also has a café, here you can get hot and cold food options. Including vegetarian, vegan and gluten-free options.



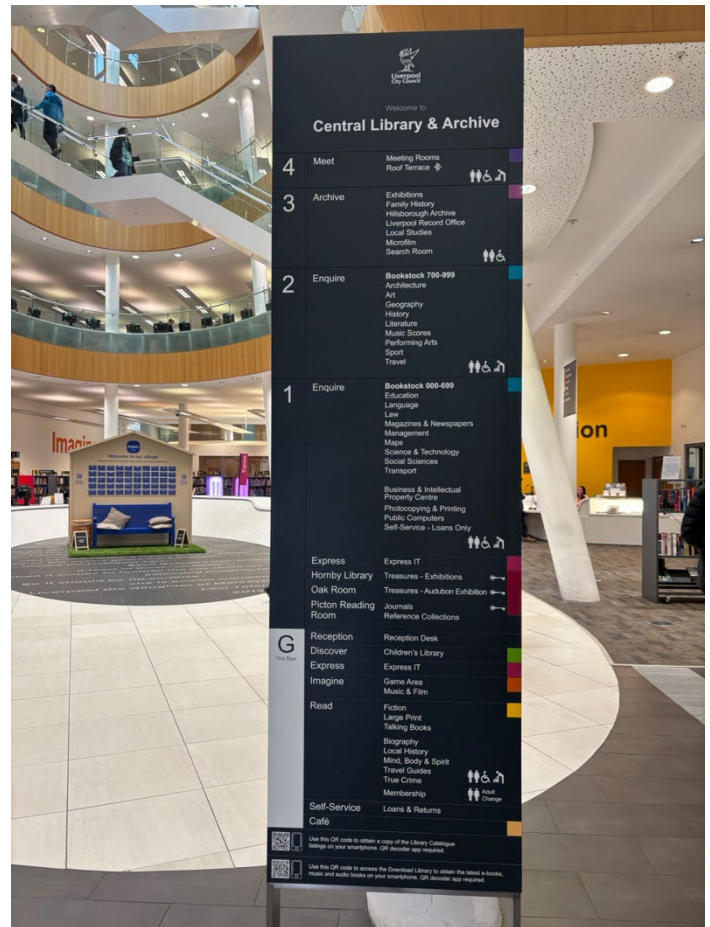
If you would like to go a little bit further afield for lunch, there are plenty of options available in St John's Shopping Centre, in Queen Square by the Bus Station or walk 10 minutes into the city centre for further options. There is also a Tesco Express available on London Road, about a 9-minute walk from the library.

World Museum:

- There are toilets on all floors, and they are all accessible to wheelchair users. There is a Changing Places toilet on the first floor. Please collect a key from the Information Desk on the Ground Floor if you wish to use this.
- There are two lifts to all floors and another lift from level three to level five.
- Seating and benches are available throughout the museum.

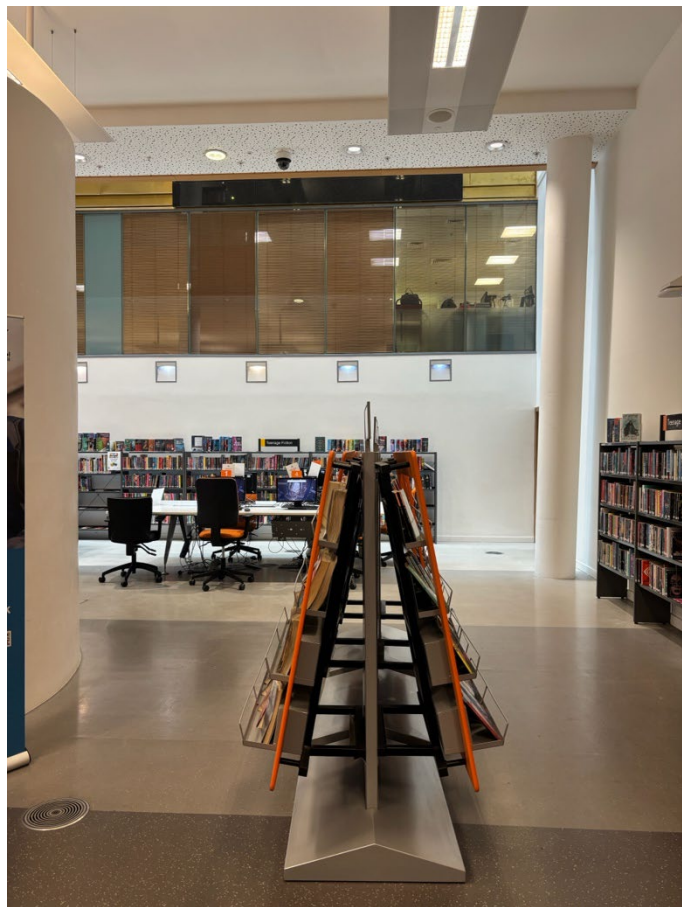




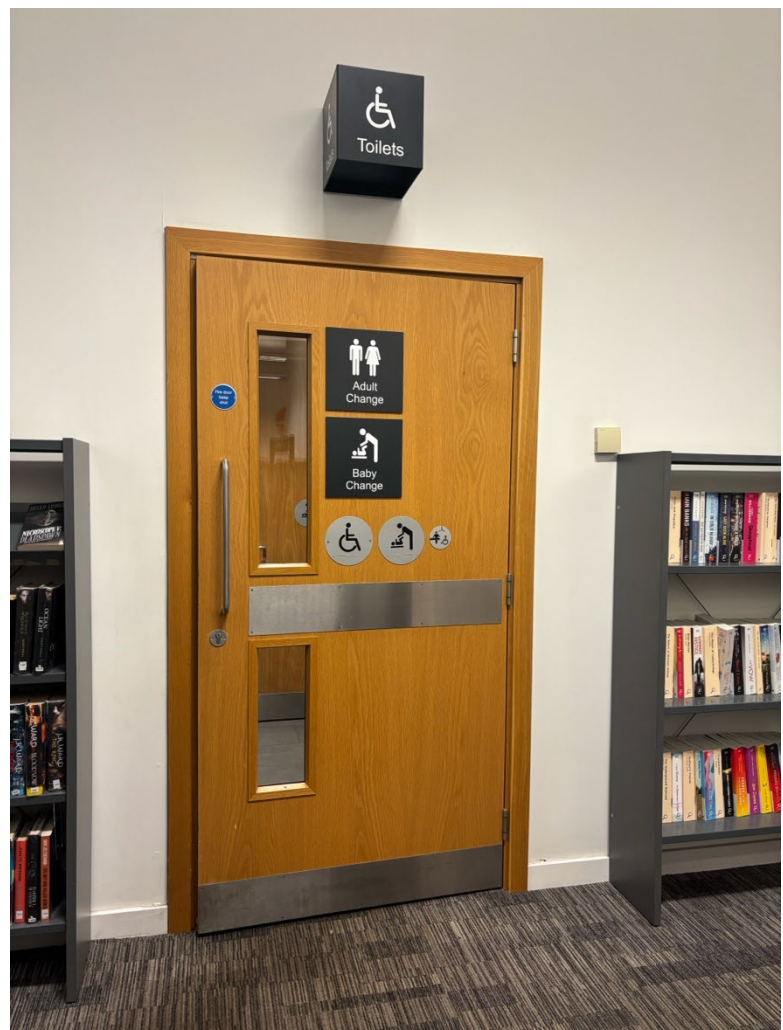

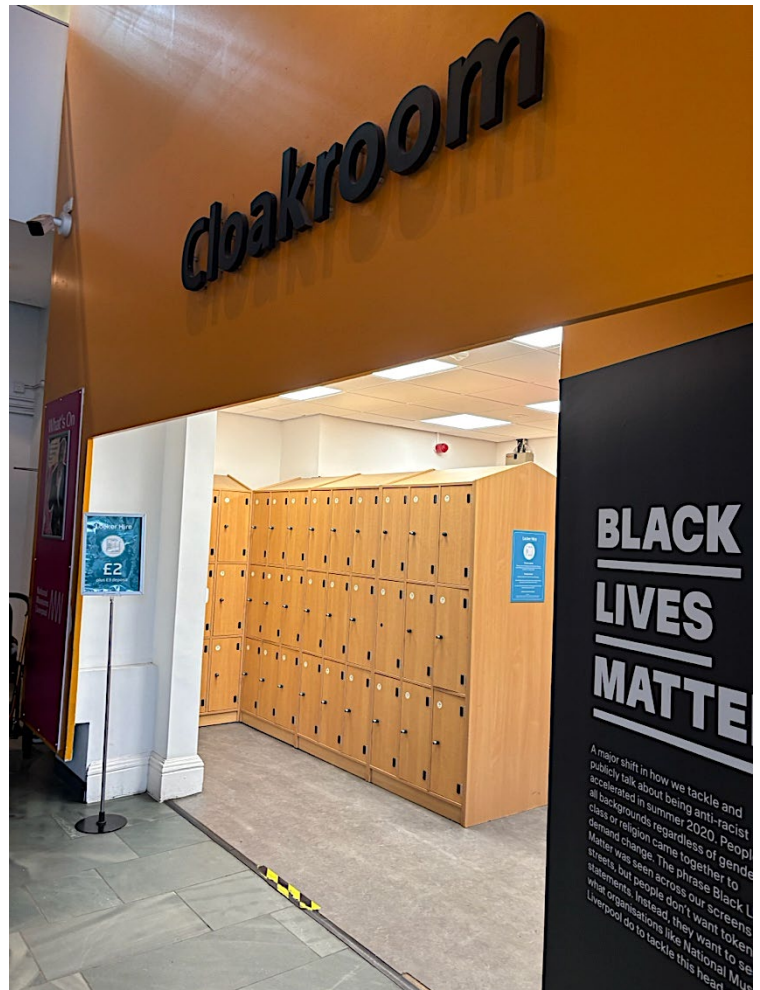
